- Principal's Report: Jen Andrews
 - Book fair – Jen worked with Mrs. Schmitz

 - Aims school testing starts next week
 - Act 20
 - As part of Wisconsin's commitment to supporting strong reading skills, all schools are required to provide science-based early literacy instruction.
 - Screeners on all students; state tells us what to do
 - Get data on literacy
 - Sooner we get data, sooner we can do something about it
 - Personal reading plans available based on results
 - Last year: One metric for 1st grade was how fast you can read – pace
 - Now composite of 4 different things
 - Principals will take (3) 1st grade classes each to do an hour of special learning to help make the tests more meaningful/engaging for the students
 - Assemblies once per month
 - Student of the month; nominated by teachers
 - 54 students
 - Will be highlighted at the assembly and online (if they have parent's permission)
 - Falcon Feathers
 - Pieces of paper that can be awarded to students when they do special things
 - Kids helping to provide ideas for how students can earn
 - Ex. Great listening, helpful, etc.
 - A way to recognize kids for positive behavior
 - Building leadership team next week
 - May streamline Halloween to story book characters instead of by grade
