

## October 2025

### Volunteer Requirement

In addition to the required background check, SFES requires volunteers to complete online Title IX training in order to work with children in the school. Upon completing the background check, you'll receive an email from Sheboygan Falls School Vector Training and be assigned the Title IX training module through the Vector Training system. This online training takes roughly 48 minutes to complete. While it is an extra step, it is necessary to ensure the safety of our children in addition to awareness for all families. The training is required every 2 years, so if you completed last year, you will not be required to retake this year; but you'll still need to complete a background check since that is required each year. Thank you to those of you who have already completed!

*Please note, this is required to volunteer at the book fair.*
